MISSA BREVIS IN HONOREM S. JOANNIS DE DEO.
("Little Organ Mass")

Kyrie - Gloria - Credo - Sanctus - Benedictus - Agnus Dei.

The "Little Organ Mass" was composed around 1775 for the chapel,
in Eisenstadt, of the Brothers of Mercy. The Mass was the last
composed in this abbreviated form by Haydn. This example of
"Missa Brevis" form is unusual because it departs from the custom
of shortening the Mass by omitting the Credo. Rather than making
this 'cut', Haydn achieved the desired effect by telescoping the
full text. Each voice part sings a different set of words
simultaneously.
