A SPECIAL feature of Christmas are the Nantwich Choral Society's concerts at Nantwich Parish Church. The annual concert has proved so popular in recent years that it was decided to give afternoon and evening performances — and both attracted large audiences.

An innovation was the introduction of school choirs, Bedford Street County Infants (directed by Mrs. Telford) and Highfields primary (Mrs. Drysdale) in the afternoon, and Church Coppenhall Juniors (Mrs. Richardson) at the evening concert. All the choirs were winners in a contest organised by the choral society.
