MUSIC lovers turned out in force to a charity performance by Nantwich Choral Society.

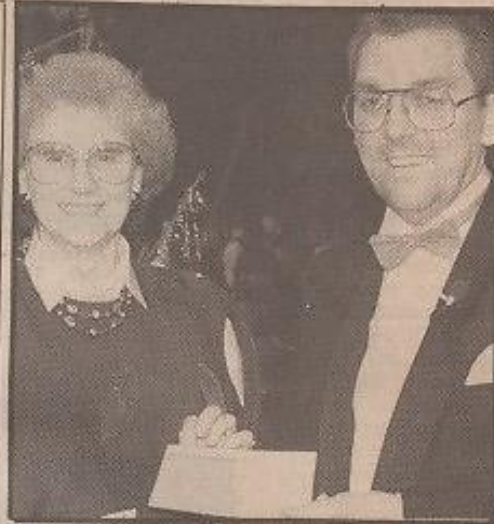
The crowd-pulling concert, which was staged at St Mary's Church, drew a capacity audience.
